## Get to Know Us

Marium Foundation (MF), a nonprofit organization, began its journey in 2012 with a group of dedicated ladies from Bani Gala united by a single mission: to make quality education accessible to underprivileged children in Pakistan. Named after حضرت مریم (A.S.), the foundation was born out of a deep commitment to transforming the lives of children and their mothers—two groups often overlooked by society. In 2017, MF established the Marium School Foundation (MSF) with just seven children in a small, one-room school, which has since grown to educate over 400 students, with plans to expand to 1,000. Understanding that true empowerment begins at home, MF launched the Women Empowerment and Facilitation Association (WEFA) to provide mothers with skill-building programs in stitching, jewelry making, and other NAVTTC-accredited vocational skills, enabling them to earn a livelihood and gain financial independence. Today, MF continues to work towards its vision of breaking the cycle of poverty and fostering self-reliant communities through education, digital skills, technical training, health, and nutrition initiatives.

## What is EFE ?

EFE (Education For Empowerment) is all about giving children a second chance. For those who have missed out on formal education or are too old to return to traditional school settings, EFE opens new doors through digital learning. By teaching them essential digital and practical skills, the program empowers these children to create brighter futures for themselves. EFE goes beyond just education; it equips students with Chromebooks and tools that help them thrive in today's tech-driven world. It's about making sure every child, regardless of their background, has the opportunity to learn, grow, and succeed

## Back To School

The Back to School (BTS) program by the Marium Foundation focuses on reintegrating children aged 8 to 14, often from diverse language backgrounds and with no prior schooling, into formal education within one year. By providing monthly rations and financial aid to their families, BTS helps prioritize education. The program emphasizes multi-language learning to ensure inclusivity. Alhamdulillah, over the past five years, BTS has successfully shifted more than 500 children into the regular school system, giving them a brighter future through education.

## Digital Skills Class

This program under the (EFE) initiative is offered to grade 5 students at the Marium Foundation in collaboration with Rehan Allahwala. The program equips students with valuable skills in graphic design and digital marketing, fostering creativity and technical proficiency. The aim is to train students over five years, preparing them for entrepreneurship in the digital world. Upon completing matriculation, they have the potential to earn up to \$500 per month as entrepreneurs.





# HEALTH AND NUTRITION PROGRAM

## HNP



The Marium Foundation's Health & Nutrition Program (HNP) plays a vital role in addressing malnutrition and health concerns among students by providing balanced, nutritious meals and regular medical check-ups. With over 80% of children in Pakistan suffering from malnutrition, our program ensures that every student receives the essential nutrition they need for proper growth and development. In addition to daily meals, the program includes weekly medical check-ups and screenings. This year, many students were diagnosed with eyesight weaknesses, and we provided them with glasses to help improve their learning experience.
